If child is too young to write the essay, a parent may complete it for them. Please note it is one essay per applicant applying. Please attach the essay(s) to your application. Essays should be no more than two to four paragraphs, one page maximum, and personally signed. Content we are looking for includes, but is not limited to: how tuition money would impact your life, what the benefit of continuing education would be to you/your family, etc. Good letters are from the heart and tell the reader a short story of exactly how this money would make a difference to you. (These essays may be shared with Patriot Foundation donors and sponsors. The essay may use the first name ONLY and will not be attributed to any specific recipient.)
*I agree to accept this \$2500 scholarship grant on behalf of myself or my child(ren) and promise to use the funds as directed for the post-high school education expenses for myself or my child(ren).
